Welcome, Anthony and Shawn! We are glad to have you with us!




Welcome Staff!

Tax Reminder for Parents

Tax preparations are underway for the residents of Mount Aloysius and GLOW House. Some of the residents are employed at PerCo or Mount Aloysius and receive a paycheck and have state and federal taxes withheld. The residents also receive a W-2 form at the end of the year. In previous years, we have received calls from parents asking if the residents file tax returns. In order for a resident to be claimed as a dependent on a tax return, the resident must have lived with you for more than half of the year. A parent must have also provided for more than half the support for the year. For additional information, please refer to the IRS website.

Easter Travel Days

If you plan to have a resident visit you during the Easter holiday, we ask that you please remember to communicate travel arrangements to Ben Brannon, Social Services Coordinator, or Kasey Penrod, Social Services Assistant, at least one week in advance but more notice is appreciated if we need to transport a resident in any way, i.e. airport, bus station, meeting place, etc. This will allow us to arrange staffing, prepare doctor letters, medication, and any other needed items. We need at least a 3 to 5 day notice in order for Nursing to make sure they have enough medication on hand.

All travel arrangements and visits to GLOW House should also be arranged with Ben or Kasey. It is important to remember that there are only two staff working at GLOW House. We will need to have advance notice if we will need to transport the resident in any way.

The following are planned travel days for the Easter holiday: Thursday, April 19th; Friday, April 20th, Monday, April 22nd, and Tuesday, April 23rd.

If there is inclement weather, Mount Aloysius will not transport residents. We cannot endanger the lives of residents and staff by driving during dangerous weather conditions. Please keep in mind that if there is inclement weather, travel arrangements may need delayed until the roads are cleared or until another day.

Options Unlimited Update Submitted by Harold Gilbert

In June, Options started a new schedule to improve the services our men receive. We learned several things from this trial and have again changed our schedule with input from residents, direct support staff, and Program Supervisors. This has allowed to provide services on days and times that best suit the individual. It has also allowed Options staff to schedule more outings for the men we serve.

We are in the process of getting our charitable bingo license. This will allow us to have regular bingo games on site and also partner with local businesses to sell rip-off bingo cards. Hopefully, this will produce funds for the continued improvement of our facility and services.

Options staff, Phillip Hembree and Morgan McFann, continue to help when asked. They have achieved Red Cross Instructor certification and now train all staff in CPR/First Aid. In addition, Phillip has been assisting with new staff trainings and Morgan has stepped up to greet staff on their first day and give them a tour of the grounds and facilities.

Our latest upgrade at the Activity Center is a new weight room. We have converted two rooms for the new exercise facility. These will have weight equipment, exercise bands, treadmills, and bikes available for use by our men and staff.

Our Spring Bazaar is scheduled for April 13th. We have had a lot of vendor interest already. This year we are investing in some new signage and other advertisements. Hopefully it will be our biggest and best yet.
